The sixteen books in this series are grouped into four levels that increase in complexity, designed to accommodate students with various reading abilities within a classroom. - Animals Care for Mother Earth comprises six contemporary, interrelated stories and supporting
 resources for teachers. In the first story, animals cooperate to clean up a polluted pond. In
 subsequent stories, they care for each other in the aftermath of the pollution problem,
 demonstrating strength of character and social responsibility. This book can be used in
 elementary schools to teach—through storytelling—the value of personal strengths and
 community supports while incorporating Tsimshian language and knowledge into classroom
 lessons. It also provides many opportunities to extend the learning to other curriculum areas,
 including science, math, reading, writing, social studies, and art.
- Not Idaho-based, but could be useful for its teachings about caring for Mother Earth, some of the animals and plants addressed may be in Idaho too.
